

Notification of Retirement Registered Greyhound

Greyhounds Australasia Rules: The owner or person responsible for the greyhound at the relevant time must notify the Controlling Body where the greyhound is domiciled in writing and within 10 days, if the greyhound has been retired as a pet, been transferred to an adoption program, or been exported or surrendered to another agency.

<p>Unless a greyhound is being accepted by an adoption agency approved by a Controlling Body that undertakes sterilisation, the owner or person responsible for the greyhound at the time of such retirement as a pet, adopted by an agency not approved by the controlling body or exported, must ensure that the greyhound has been surgically sterilised by a veterinarian before allowing the greyhound to leave their care and custody, except where a veterinarian certifies after examining that greyhound, to the satisfaction of a Controlling Body, that being surgically sterilised would be detrimental to its welfare.</p>
